The Interview Game

Can you prove you're the best fit
for the job?!

Rules:

- One student will be designated as the interviewer, and the rest will be applicants.
- The interviewer will choose a job position and conduct an interview with an applicant.
- The applicant will have 1-2 minutes to prove with reason and confidence why they are the best fit for the job!
- If the interviewer is impressed with the applicant, then they will say “You’re Hired!” If they are not impressed, then its “We’ll get back to you”.
- The interviewer will then move on to a new position with a new applicant.
- Continue until all applicants have been interviewed and then switch roles to continue the fun.

Job Positions

Taxi Comedian

- You will be required to give jokes and entertainment to customers riding in taxis.

Family Mart Velociraptor

- You will be required to roam around the store as a hungry velociraptor.

Pigeon Greeter

- You will be required to give all pigeons a warm greeting when they enter the park.

Vending Machine Looker

- You will be required to stare at people as they use the vending machine, no talking, only staring.

Train Station Personal Trainer

- You will be required to give exercise lessons to people waiting for their train.

Tree English Teacher

- You will be required to give English lessons to local trees at the park.

Script

Use this script to help the game go smoothly. Refer to the Job Positions slide for positions and their descriptions.

Interviewer: I see you have applied for the Family Mart Velociraptor position. You will be required to roam around the store as a hungry velociraptor. Why do you think you are best for this position?

Applicant: Give a 1-2 min explanation for why you would be good for the role. Be CONFIDENT and embrace this role!

Interviewer: “You’re Hired” or “We’ll get back to you”
